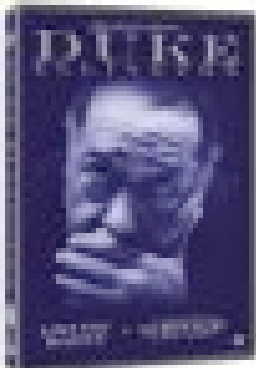
**ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING and FILM PROGRAM**
